What are my options?

Did you know?

- **Medication abortion care:** Many local Family Doctors and Nurse Practitioners offer abortion medication up to 10 weeks pregnant. You can ask your care provider if they offer this. There are in person services available in Muskoka (see below). There is also a Midwifery-led virtual option in Midland (see below).
- **Surgical abortion care:** If you are less than 13 weeks pregnant, you do not have to travel out of the region (you have options). Refer to the table below *or you* can call the Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit and speak with a Sexual Health Public Health Nurse: 705-721-7520 or toll free at 1-877-721-7520 press 3.
