

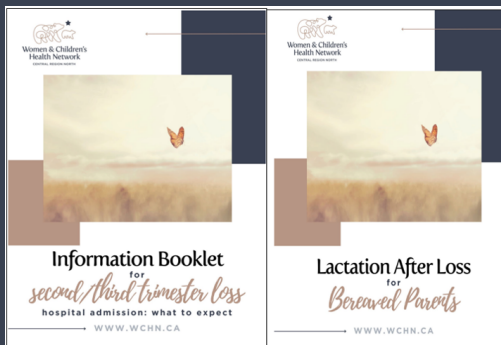

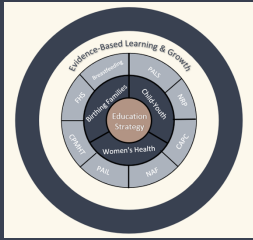

The second link is to the HQO standards and addresses care for children, young people, and adults with sickle cell disease. This link also provides a patient guide and quick reference guide ("placemat").



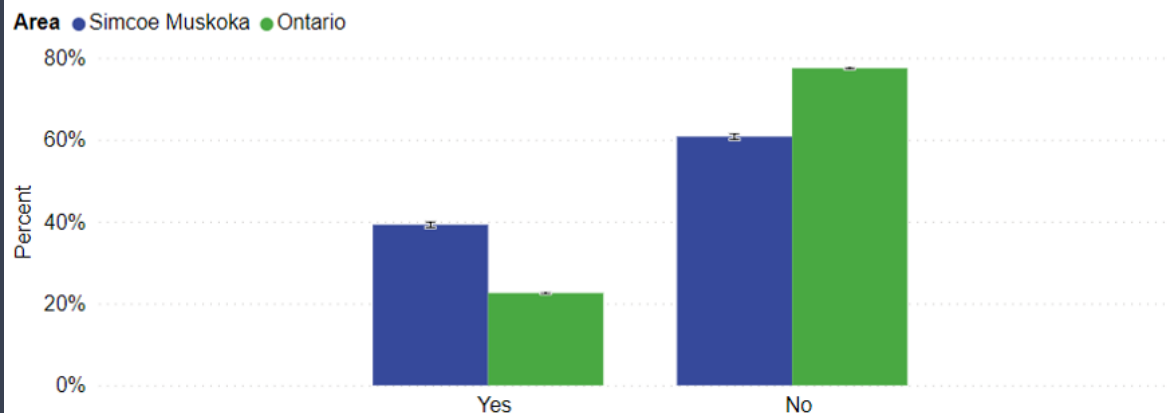
Perinatal Mental Health Task Force: Recruiting new members
