

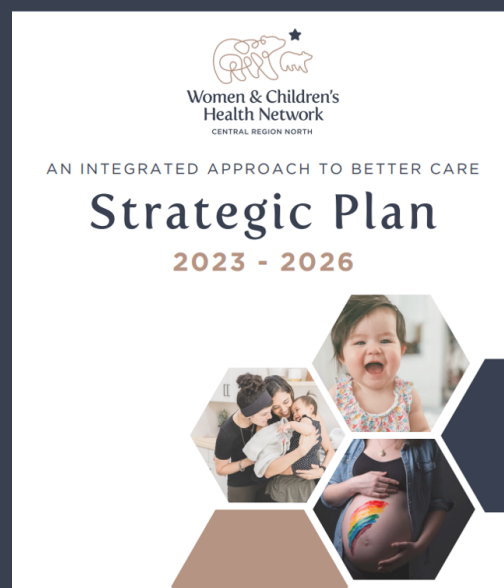

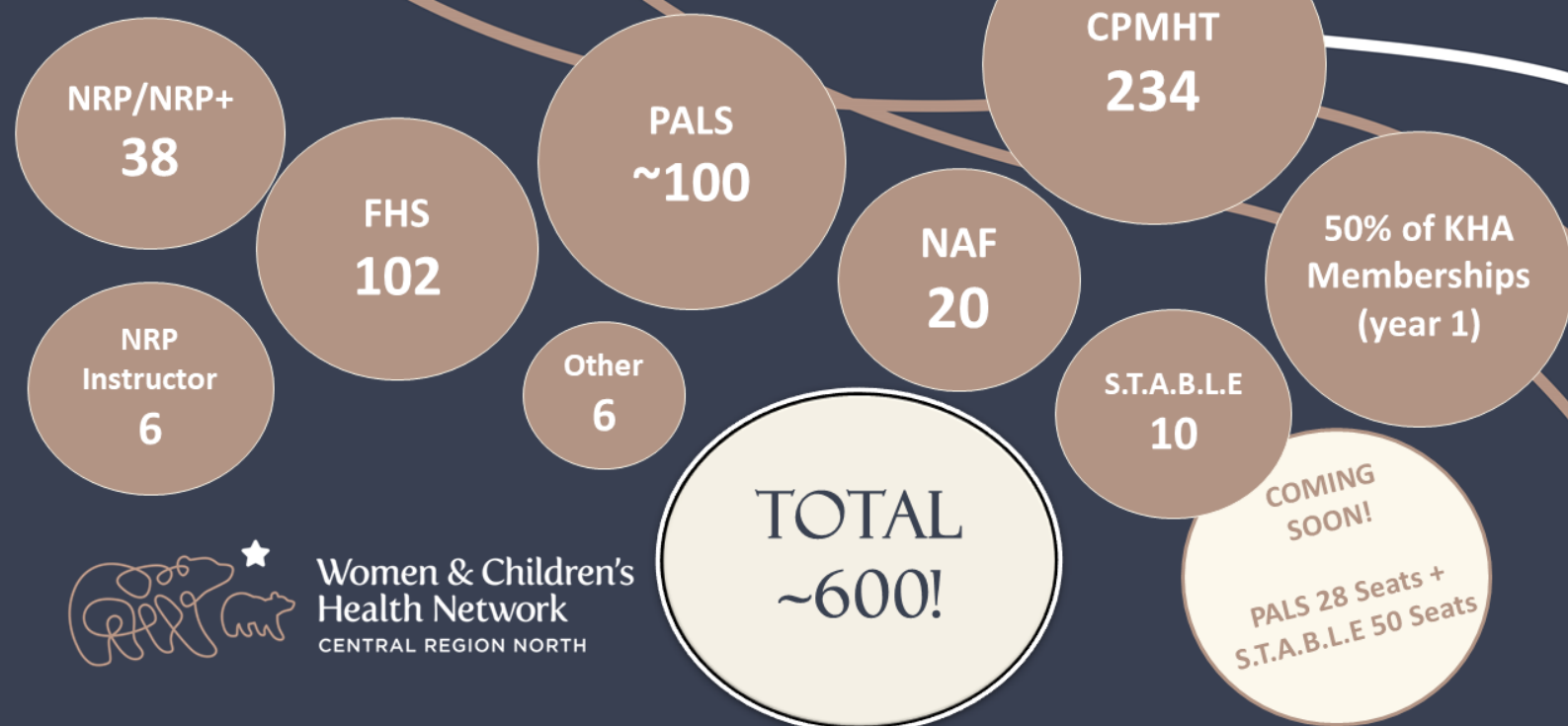

## Network-Sponsored S.T.A.B.L.E. Course

Course 1 of 5: OSMH September 14th 2023

This year, the Network will be sponsoring **5** S.T.A.B.L.E. courses across the region.

Two courses will be geared towards staff working in level 2C NICUs (OSMH and RVH) and will be one-day in duration - will be held in Orillia and Barrie. *Registration for the first one-day course at OSMH is found below.*

Three courses will be two-days in duration and will include one day of content followed by a second day of simulation/hands-on. These courses are recommended for clinicians working in level one hospitals - will be held in Muskoka, Midland and Collingwood.

However, all courses are open to all RNs, RPNs, and RRTs working in hospital settings in Central Region North + Parry Sound.
