SMDHU Breastfeeding Surveillance Update

The Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit (SMDHU) last completed surveillance of local breastfeeding data indicators in 2019 as part of maintaining Baby Friendly Initiative designation through the Breastfeeding Committee of Canada. The findings from this surveillance, [Feeding Babies in Simcoe Muskoka](#), was shared with local partners in the fall of 2020. SMDHU will resume surveillance activities later this year and looks forward to collaboratively re-engaging in work that supports, promotes and protects breastfeeding in the communities we serve.
