Perinatal Mental Health Provider Care Pathway – Central Region

About the Pathway

The Perinatal Mental Health Provider Care Pathway for the Central Region North connects healthcare providers with publicly funded or free services that support individuals experiencing perinatal mood and anxiety disorders. This pathway was developed by the Women & Children’s Health Network with reference to the Provincial Council for Maternal and Child Health (PCMCH)’s Care Pathway for the Treatment of Perinatal Mental Health.

A digital version of this localized Care Pathway can be found on the Women and Children’s Health Network website, along with more information about the network and other services and support.

This pathway is divided by subregions across Central Region North (Simcoe County, District of Muskoka, and Parry Sound), listing supports related to perinatal mental health. Each support is coded with the treatment level that best fits based on the description in the PCMCH Care Pathway for the Treatment of Perinatal Mental Health, which is guided by EPDS, GAD-7, or PHQ-9 scores and clinical judgement. Any underlined text leads to a direct link, which can be accessed by clicking on it.

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Perinatal Mental Health Provider Care Pathway – Central Region

PCMCH Care Pathway for the Treatment of Perinatal Mental Health

1. **ASK** about the well-being of the pregnant or postpartum person at every visit to identify the need for mental health support and treatment
2. **ADVISE** by providing education on perinatal mental health and arrange support to mitigate factors that are affecting mental health
3. **ASSESS** the severity of the mental health concern
4. **ASSIST** by recommending or implementing a treatment step

5. **ARRANGE** follow-ups to monitor recommended treatment plan; make modifications or changes to treatment step as required
