

French Early ON Centre

The French organization La Clé offers multiple services to Francophones in Simcoe County including a French Early ON Centre in Barrie 5 days a week and in Angus 2 days a week. The Centre also has activities based out of Penetanguishene and future plans in Tiny. This centre welcomes French speaking and French learning families with children 0 to 6 years of age.
