



Pregnancy Care Counselling Resources

Pregnancy care includes a wide range of options to support your health and well-being. If you're unsure about your options, confidential counselling is available to help you explore choices around parenting, adoption, or abortion. Abortion care in Ontario is safe, legal, and covered by OHIP, with both medical and surgical options offered in clinics, hospitals, and through telemedicine. After an abortion, emotional and physical support is available through counselling services, peer support groups, and online resources—because you are never alone in this journey.

What are my options?

All-Options uses direct service and social change strategies to promote unconditional, judgment-free support for people in all of their decisions, feelings, and experiences with pregnancy, parenting, abortion, and adoption. We recognize that these issues are complex, but one thing is certain: *Everyone deserves to have all options!*
